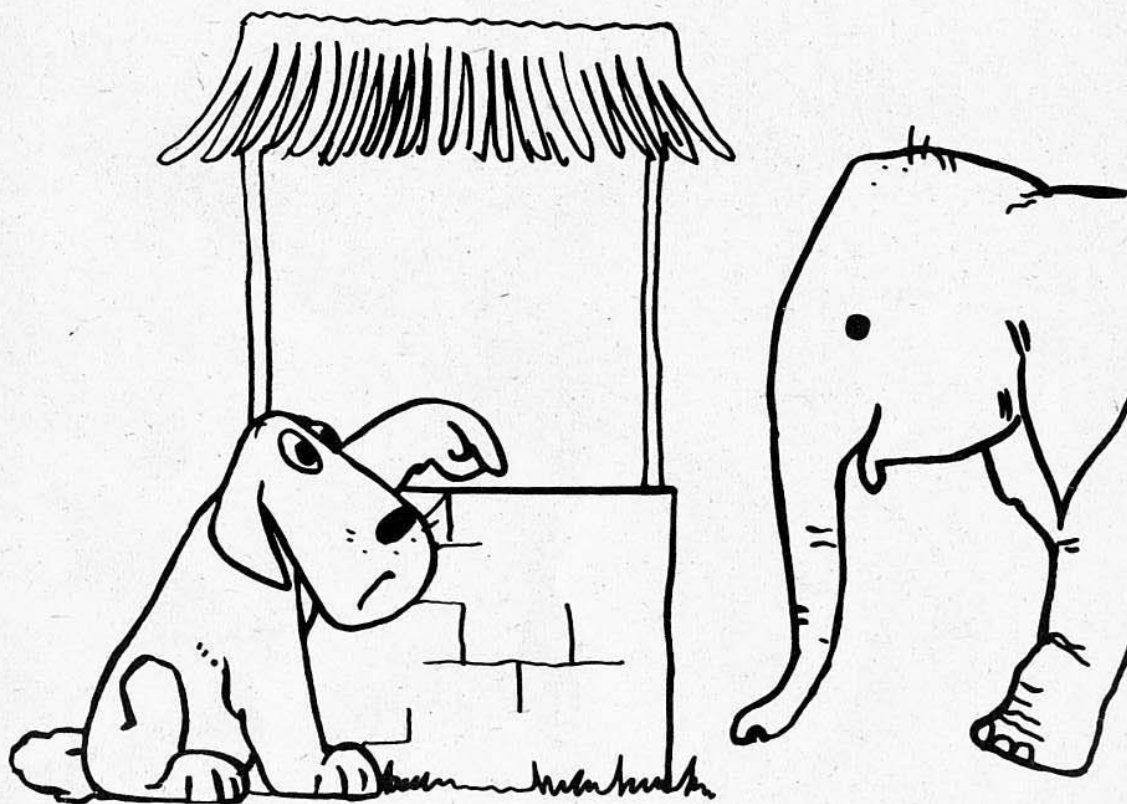


"Sis fell in it.

She needs me."

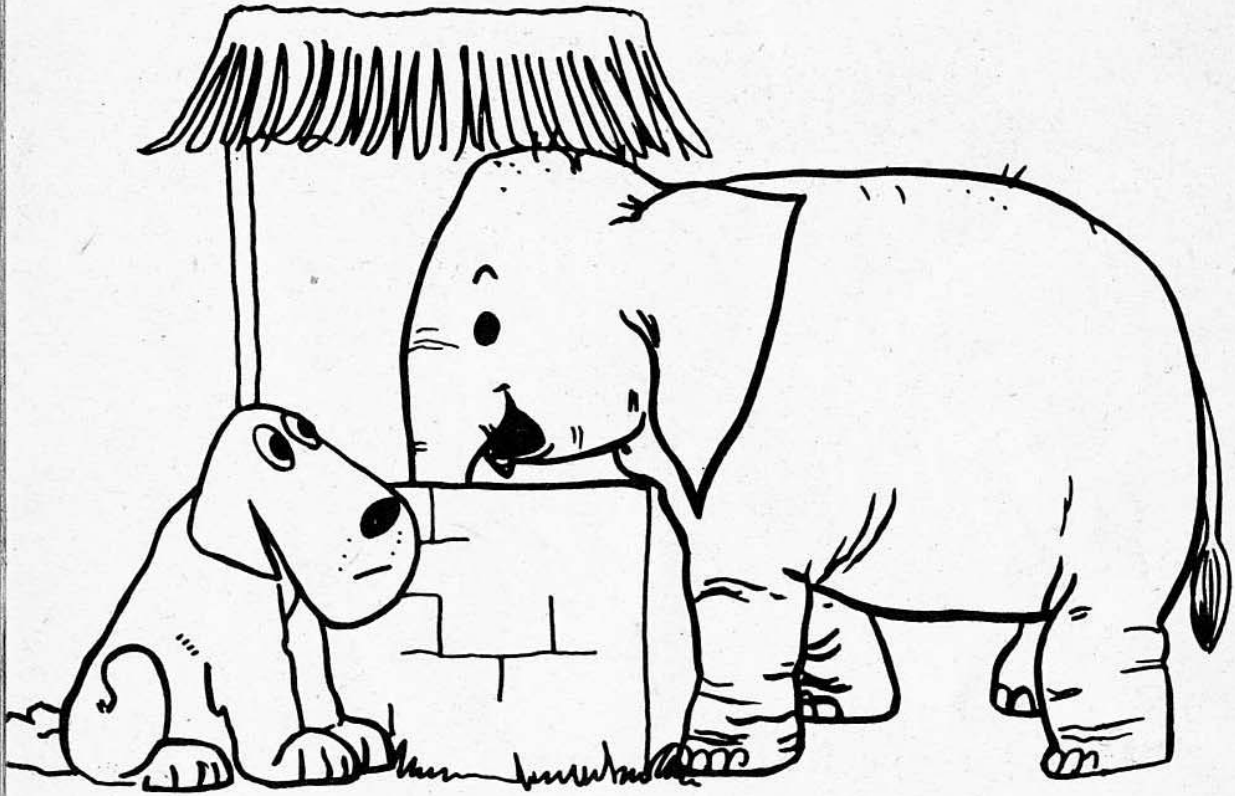

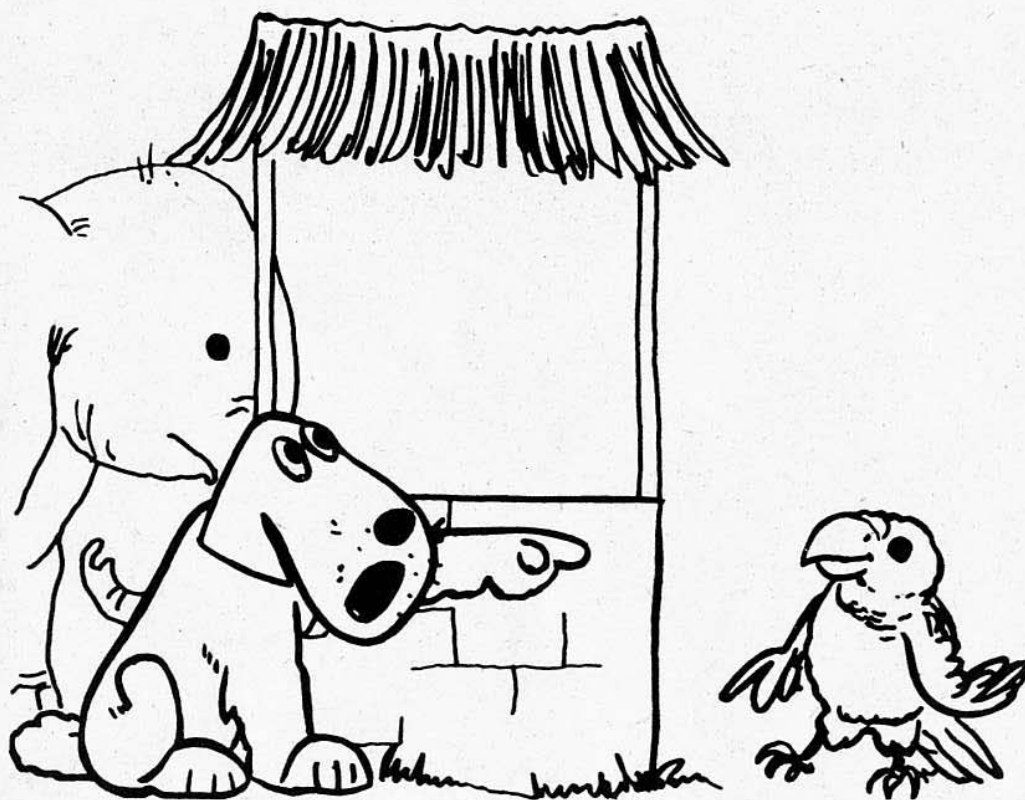
Will sees the well.

Will sees Ed.



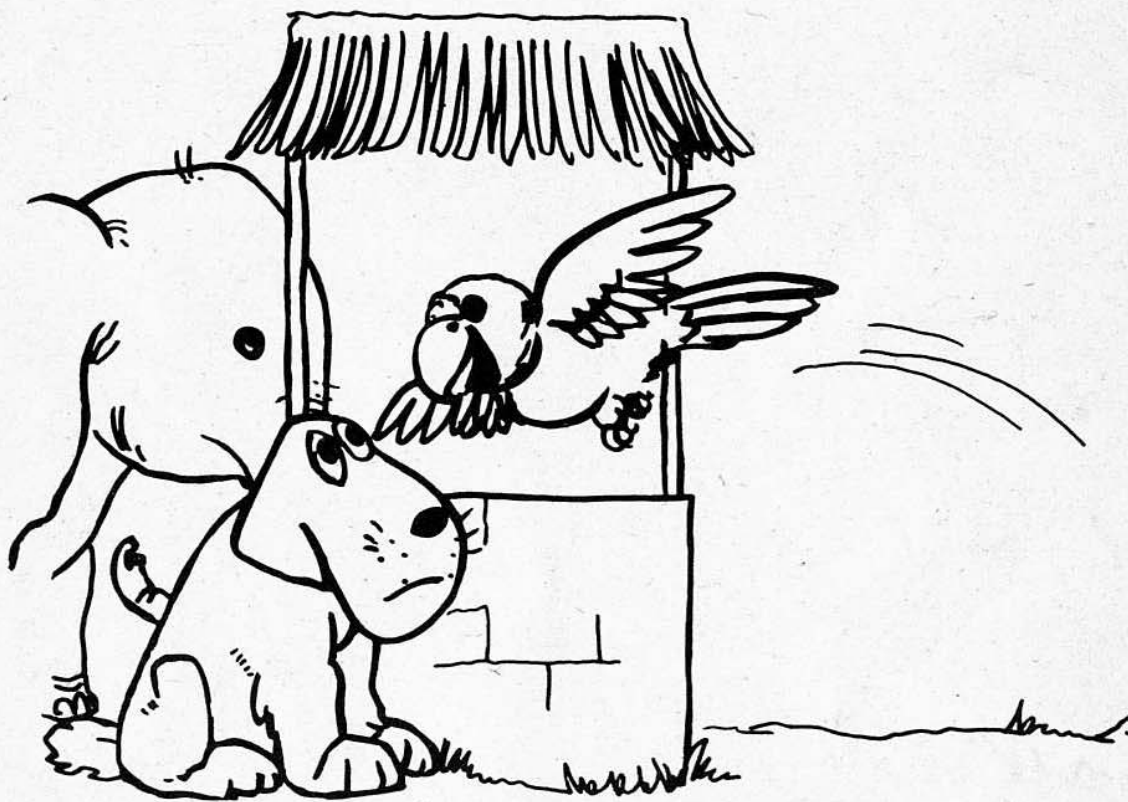

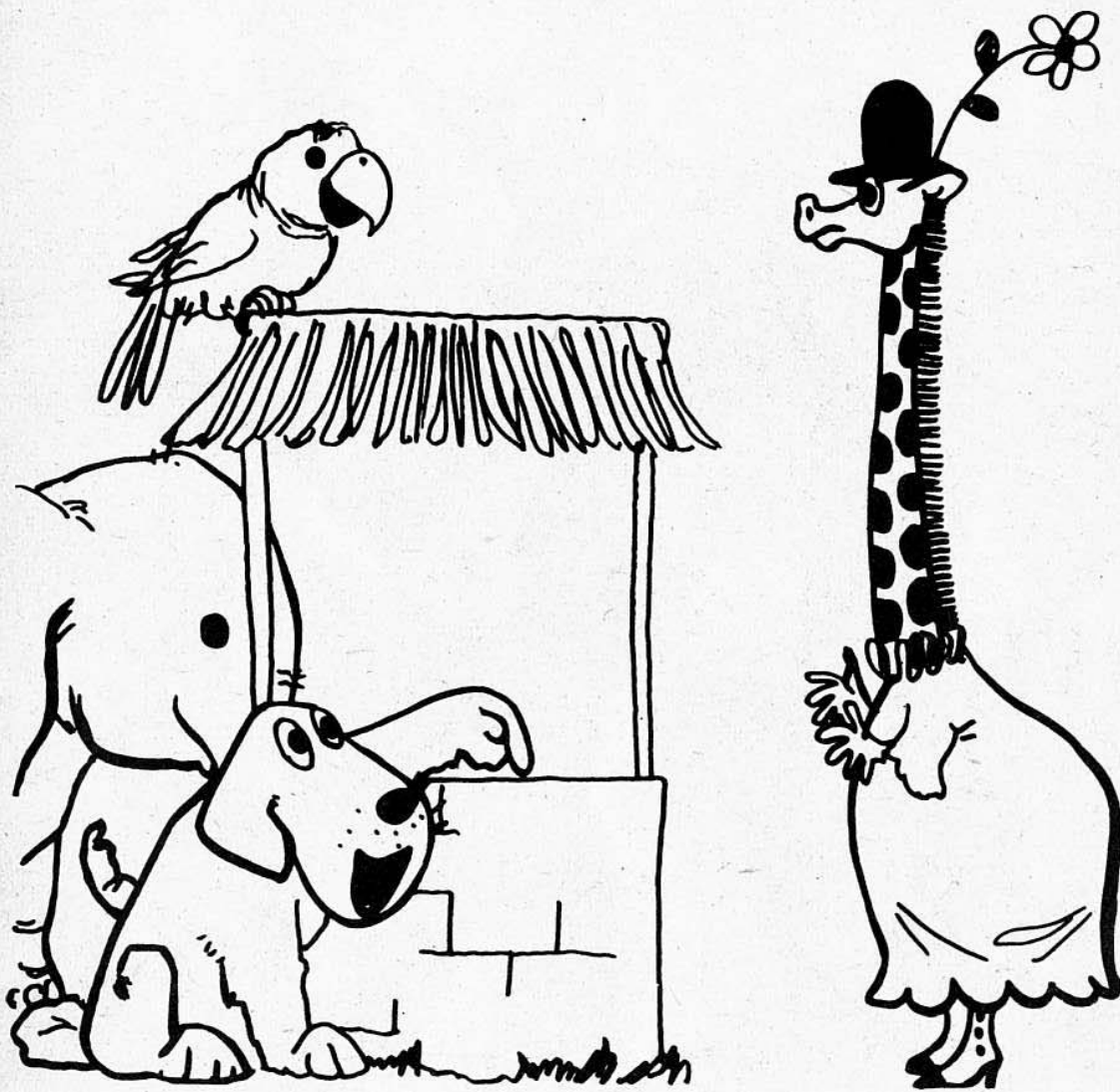


"We need Nan.

Nan, Sis fell in the well."

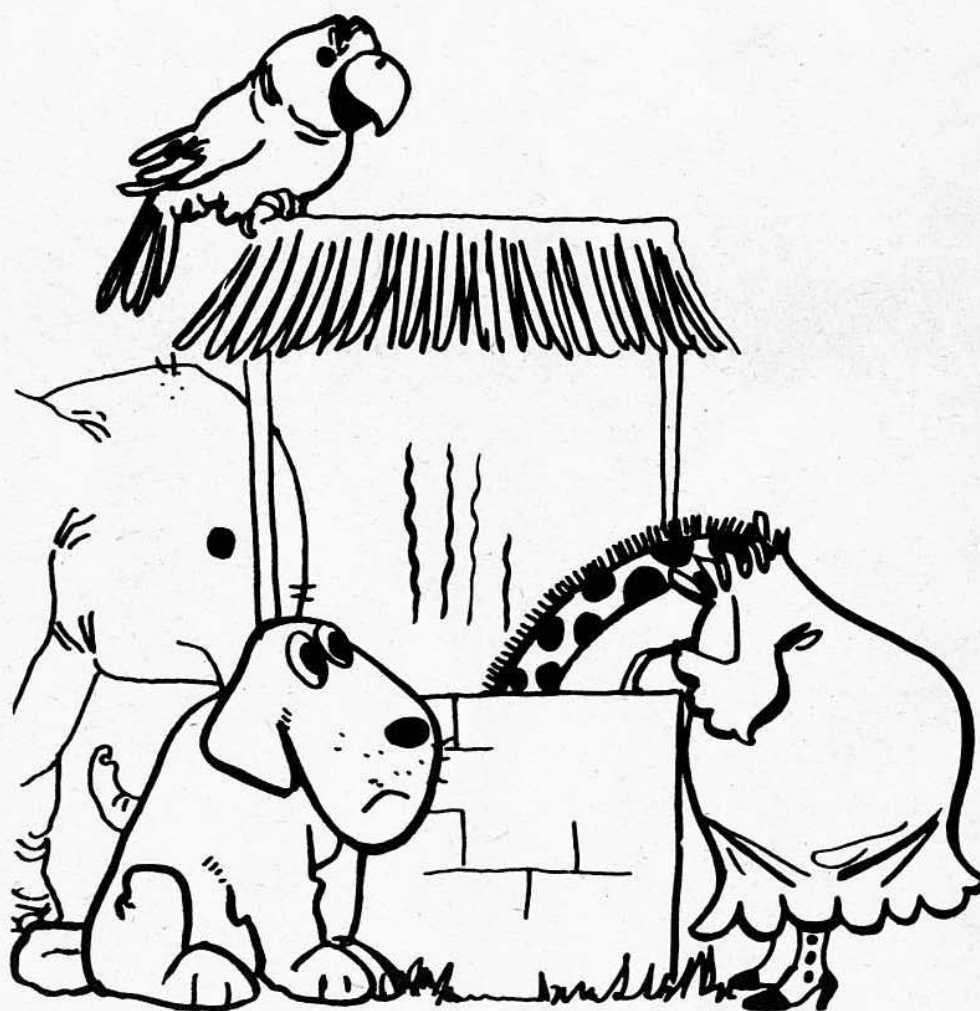


"Did she?
Let me see."

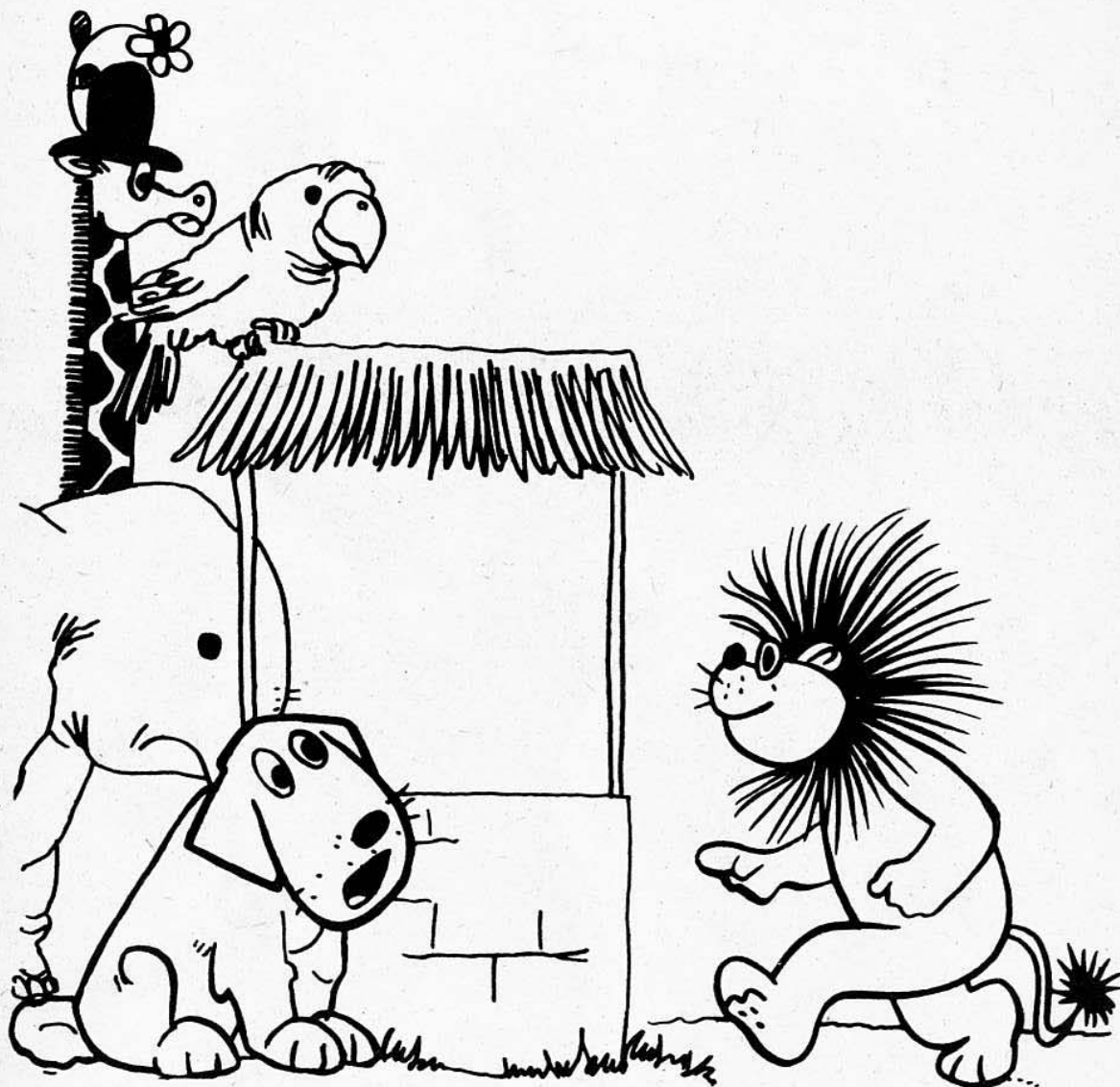


"We need Ann.
