








Bill the Bee hid in the net.




"Is the bee in this bell? Let me see if he hid in it."



"Bill!" said Ben the Ant.




"The ant hid in the bus, but I see him."

Will I fit into the bed?"




The ant hid in the bed.

He did not see the bee.




"This is bad," said the bee.

Ben! Ben!"




"Was that the bee?
