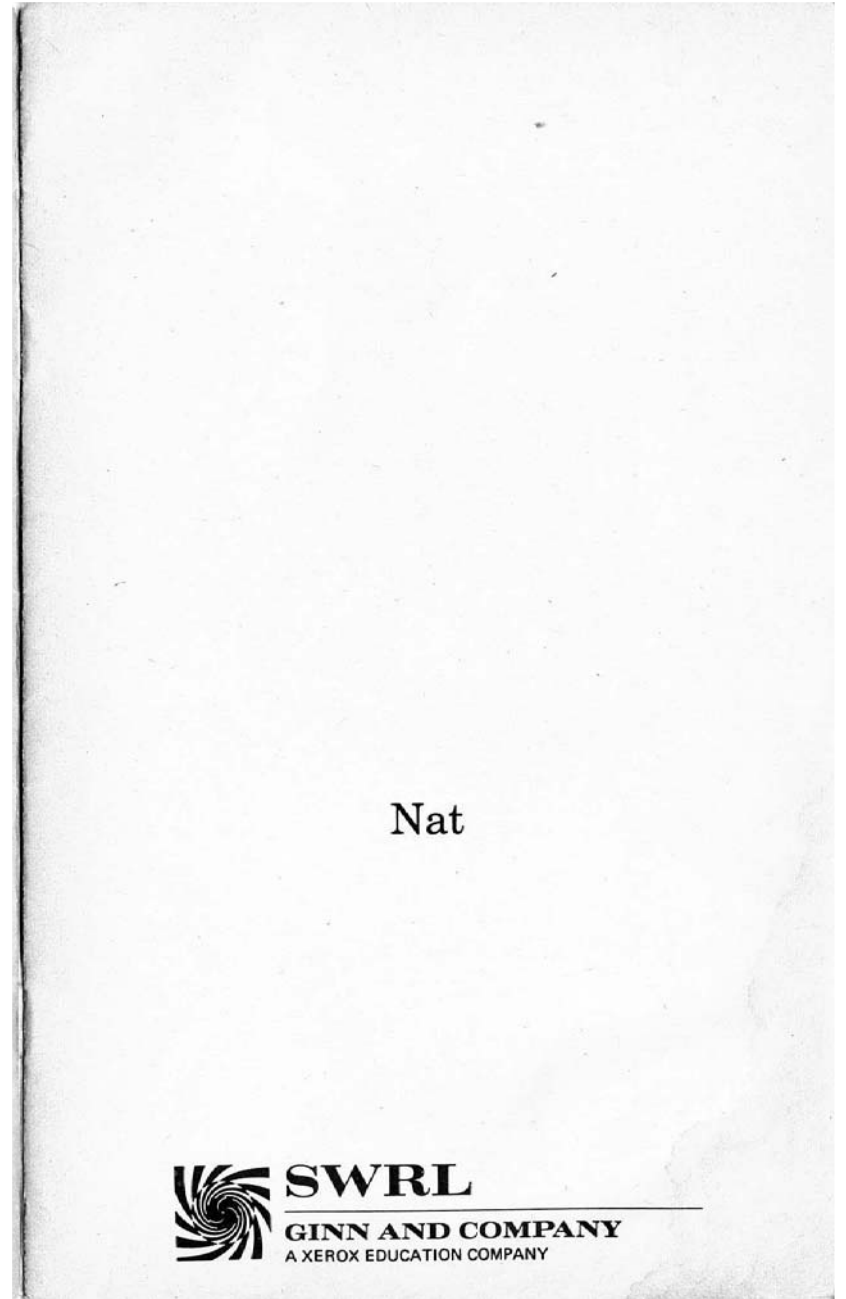
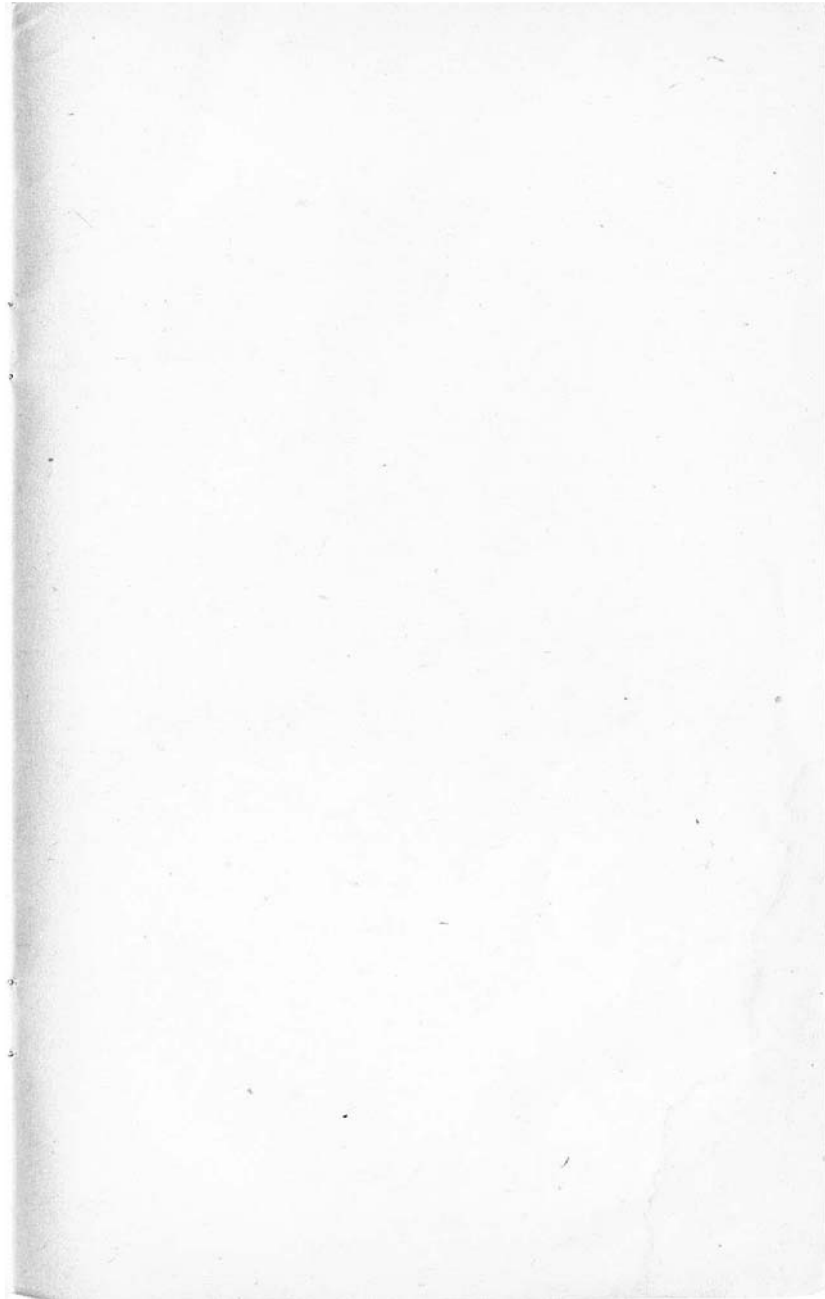

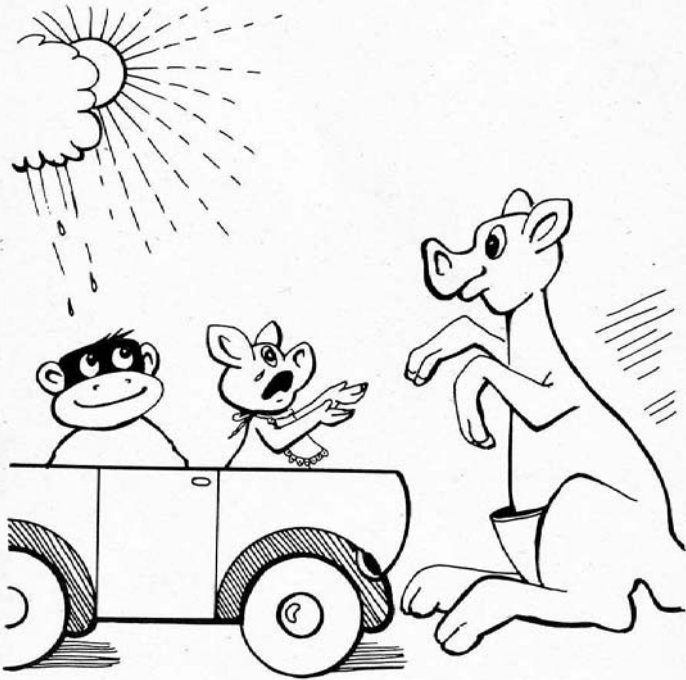

Plot Summary

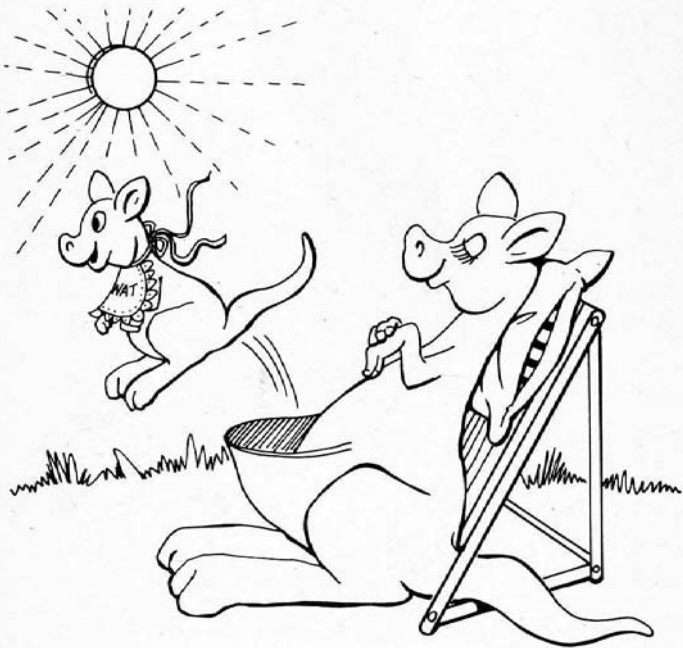

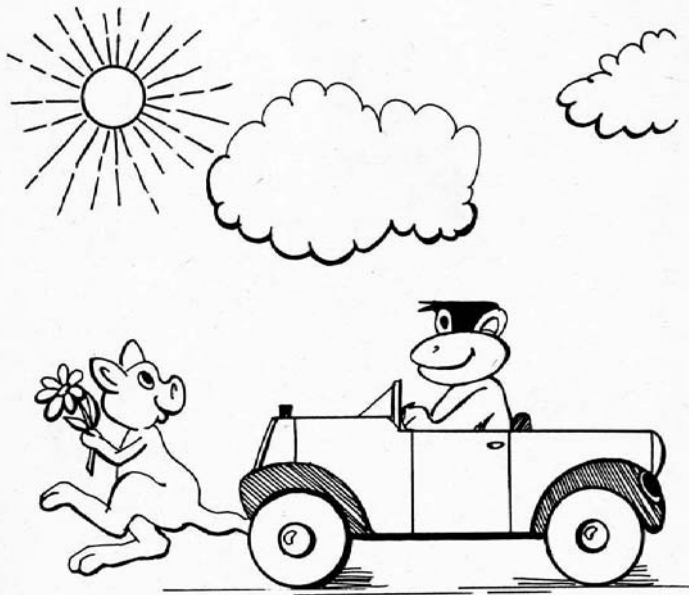
